Cookies & Cream Cheesecake

Shonda Rhimes once said "Cheesecake will always taste like love" and I couldn't agree more. Cheesecake is the perfect dessert to take to any Holiday party this year. Directions:

Ingredients: Spring Form Pan (6) Bricks of Cream Cheese, Soft (4) Eggs (2) cups of Sugar (1/2) cup of sour cream (1/4) cup of flour (1/2) cup of heavy cream 1Tbs Vanilla Xtract (1) cup of crushed oreos **Fresh Strawberries** Whole Oreos

crust:

(2) cups of crushed oreos (1/2) stick of melted butter (1/2) cup of sugar **1tsp Cinnamon**

STEP 1: Form Crust: In Med bowl, combine all crust ingredients. Once combined, line dough inside spring form Pan. Bake at 350 for 10 mins. Remove and let cool.

STEP 2: In mixing bowl, combine Cream Cheese and Sugar. Mix until incorporated. Add in eggs, 1 at a time. Mix until incorporated.

STEP 3: Add in Vanilla and Sour Cream and mix. Next, sprinkle flour over batter to form a thin layer. Pour in heavy cream and add in the crushed Oreos. Mix all Whole Oreos and Enjoy. ingredients one final time until it's all incorporated. (Do Not Over Mix)



STEP 4: Fill Batter in pan over the crust.

STEP 5: Bake Cheesecake at 300 degress for 2hrs. ((For Best Results, bake cheesecake inside a water bath))

STEP 6: Remove from oven and let cool down.
