1 Maintenance

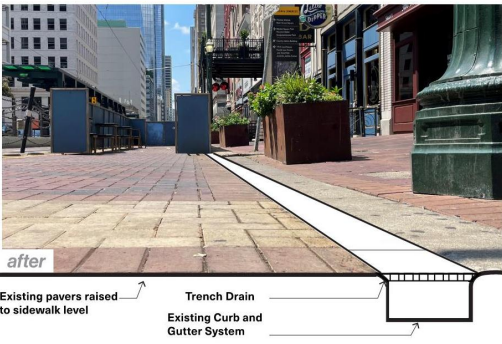
Like the ideas, but who is going to take care of this?

2 Accessibility

Raise the Street to Create Promenade
To create a flush walking surface between drive lane and sidewalk

3 Placemaking

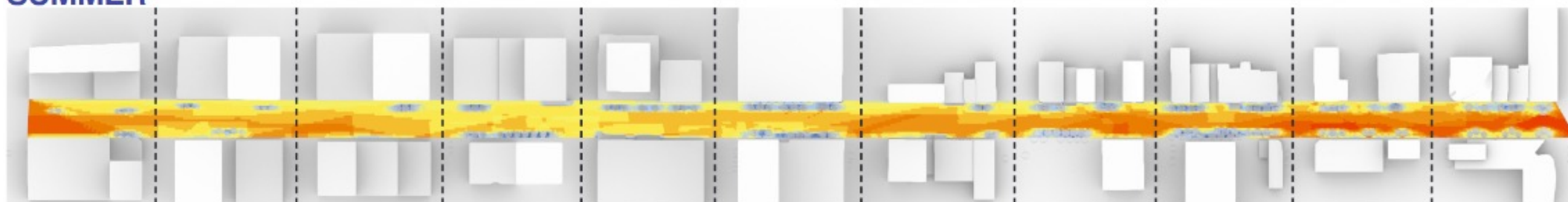

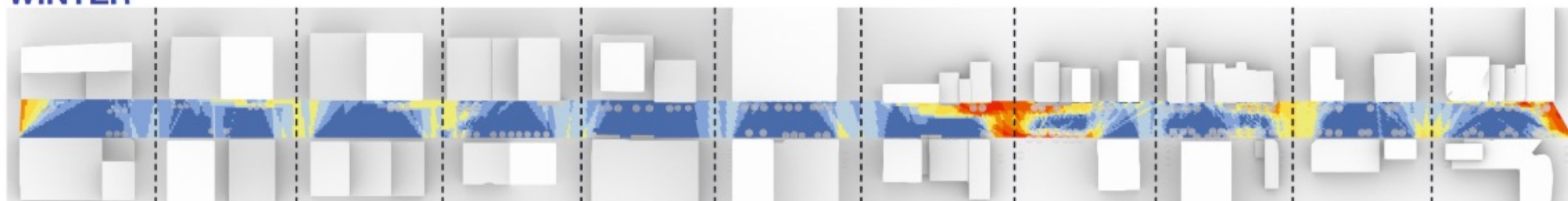

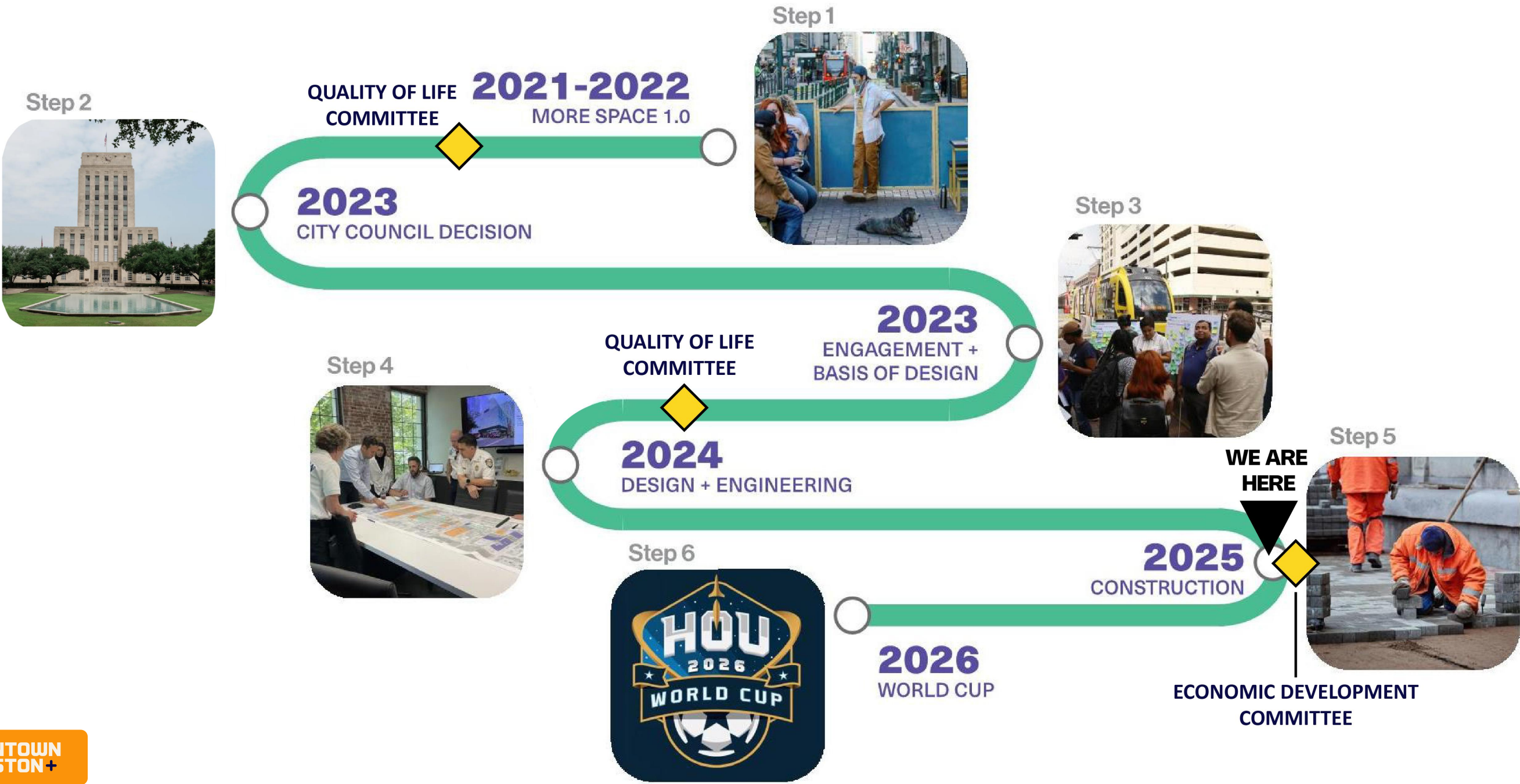
