






- Created in December 2012, City Ordinance No. 2012-1048;
- As consideration for Harris County's participation in the East Downtown TIRZ, the City agreed to create the Greater Houston TIRZ primarily for County initiated projects;
- The original Greater Houston TIRZ area includes the eastside of Downtown including Daikin Park, the George R. Brown Convention Center, Discovery Green Toyota Center and St. Joseph's Medical Center;
- It also includes a geographical area that includes NRG Stadium, generally bounded by Old Spanish Trail, Almeda Genoa Road, State Highway 288 and Main Street.





- In August 2015, City Council enlarged the boundary of the TIRZ to include an area bounded by Interstate 45, Milby Street, Polk Street and Cullen Boulevard.
- City participation was 5% only initially;
- City Council approved 2nd Amended Project Plan and Reinvestment Zone Financing Plan in September 2020; to increase City participation to 75%;
- City Council approved the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement on December 14, 2022, Ordinance No. 2022-979, that formalized the City's increased participation in the Zone;




- City Council approved a Third Amendment to the Reinvestment Zone's Project Plan and Reinvestment Zone Financing plan on December 6, 2023, City Ordinance No. 2023-1059;
- The Third Amended Plan:
 - Increased Harris County's project costs;
 - Added an affordable housing budget of \$100M in related project costs;
 - Identified short-term and long-term capital improvements in the Southern Sector and the Cullen Area in the Northern Sector;
 - Contemplated a bond issuance by Harris County to fund their public improvements and Affordable Housing Plan.

- In March 2024, City Council approved a Debt Authorization of \$65 million to issue debt for Harris County related projects, using Harris County funding.
- The Texas Attorney General's Office requires all tax increment revenue to be deposited into a single fund. Harris County and the City will issue debt through the proposed entity (LGC/RDA); creating a structure consistent with other TIRZs.
