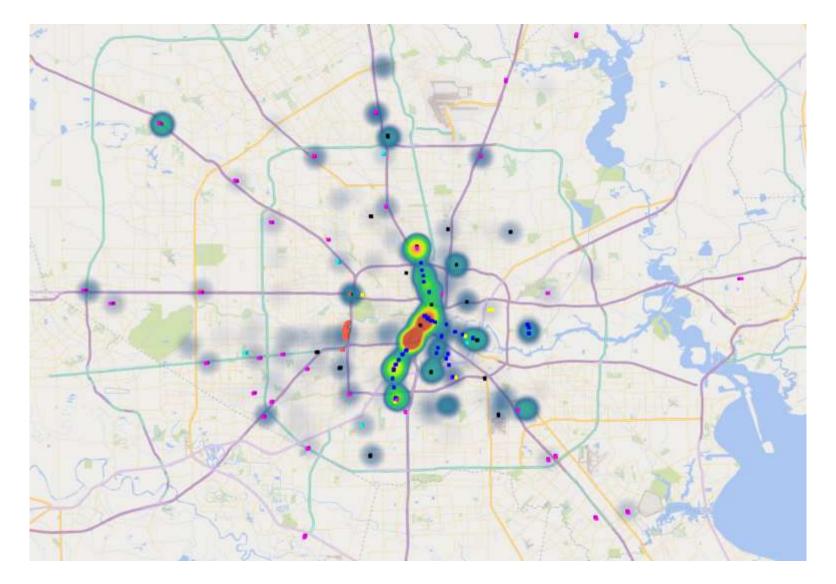

Areas of Responsibility









- MPD reached full staffing earlier this year, a major milestone.
- Satellite substations now expand our visibility and improve response times.
- Our jurisdiction spans 1,300 square miles, so decentralization ensures faster, more responsive coverage in areas that need more attention.





- MPD works closely with HPD, Harris County Sheriff's Office, and federal partners to ensure rapid response and coordinated safety.
- Partnerships with Veterans Affairs, social services, and mental health providers extend our reach beyond enforcement.
- These collaborations have turned enforcement moments into opportunities for rehabilitation and support.





- Morning Operations: Proactive morning outreach to keep platforms and vehicles clear, safe, and welcoming.
- **Platform Presence:** Visible operations with officers and K9s to deter crime and reassure riders.
- CARE Unit: Six clinicians plus officers addressing homelessness and mental health with compassion, not just enforcement.
 - o Averages 200 contacts per week, connecting people to shelters, medical care, and veteran benefits.
 - o Represents MPD's shift toward community-based policing and problem-solving.
- Community Engagement: Youth outreach, ride-alongs, and partnerships with schools and local organizations to strengthen public trust.







- Achieved full staffing and strengthened security through satellite substations.
- Preparing for FIFA World Cup 2026, ensuring Houston's transit system is secure for global visitors.
- Continued focus on training, technology, and transparency to meet Houston's evolving needs.
