Trust & Safety Tools

LERT Portal

Provides a secure and streamlined channel for law enforcement to submit valid legal requests for information from Airbnb.

Reservation Screening

We have a data-driven system for flagging and stopping potentially suspicious reservations.



Party Ban

Global ban on parties and events at Airbnb listings in addition to a number of other measures to address parties.

Neighborhood Support Hotline

Tool for members of the community to reach Airbnb and report any issues with listings in their neighborhood.

ID Verification & Background Checks

Technologies to help ensure you are who you say you are.

Being a Good Neighbor

Airbnb does not allow:

- <u>Disruptive gatherings:</u> Gatherings that threaten the safety of or disturb the surrounding community are not allowed, regardless of size.
- <u>"Party house" listings:</u> Hosts should not encourage or otherwise permit disruptive gatherings, parties, or events in their listing descriptions or elsewhere.
- <u>Community nuisances:</u> Disruptive behavior and actions including excessive smoking around neighbors or smoking in areas where smoking is prohibited, littering, making excessive noise, or obstructing neighbors' access to their homes aren't allowed.

Reservation Screening Technology:

 Our proprietary technology analyzes hundreds of factors in each reservation and blocks certain bookings that show a high risk for disruptive parties and property damage.

ID Verification & Background Checks

Airbnb requires users to undergo ID verification when they try to make bookings.

Verifying the identity of guests and Hosts helps us to:

- Check that people are who they say they are
- Do background checks (for safety and security, sanctions etc.)
- Understand if a malicious actor has taken control of an account
- Investigate safety and security issues such as assault, robbery or fraudulent activity
