

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) proposes an ordinance adopting the 2021 Winter Storm Single Family Home Repair Program Guidelines. The program will provide financial and/or rehabilitation assistance to eligible low-and-moderate-income (LMI) and Urgent Need (UN) households whose primary residence was directly or indirectly impacted by the 2021 Winter Storm Uri through two pathways as outlined below.

- The Reimbursement Pathway will assist LMI households and UN households up to 120% Area Median Income.
- The Rehabilitation or Reconstruction Pathway will assist LMI households with an annual income at or below 80% of Area Median Income.

Applicants who resided in the City of Houston jurisdiction between February 13-17, 2021, at the time of the storm, at a property that served as the applicant's primary residence may be eligible for assistance.

The public has thirty (30) days to comment on this proposed item. The 30-day period extends from Tuesday, February 4, 2025, through Tuesday, March 4, 2025. Upon completion of the 30-day public comment period, HCDD will take this item to the City Council. For additional information on this item, contact Kenneth Brown at (832) 469-5834.
