The City of Houston's (City) Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) proposes an ordinance to adopt Public Services guidelines for the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery 2024 (CDBG DR-24) Homeless Services Program (Program). The Program will fund non-profit organizations and/or units of local government as subrecipients to prevent or address homelessness. Subrecipients will provide shelter operations, case management, and supportive services to assist individuals at risk of or experiencing homelessness who were impacted by the 2024 Derecho and Hurricane Beryl storms.
