

## Public Notice

The City of Houston's (City) Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) proposes an ordinance to adopt guidelines for the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery 2024 (CDBG-DR24) Single Family Home Repair Program (Program). The Program will rehabilitate or reconstruct homes for low-and-moderate income (LMI) households whose principal residence were directly or indirectly impacted by the Derecho windstorm and/or Hurricane Beryl in 2024.

The maximum amount of assistance per program activity is as follows:

- **Rehabilitation:** Eligible households may receive a maximum award up to \$100,000.00.
- **Reconstruction:** Eligible households may receive a maximum award up to \$300,000.00.
