The program will provide new affordable single-family homes for low- and moderate-income homebuyers. The first notice was published on November 26, 2018 through December 26, 2018. The second notice was published on January 29,2021 through Sunday, February 28, 2021.

- Updated Affordability Period Chart. .
- Added additional Conflict-of-Interest ٠ language on requirements.
- Removed Flood insurance requirements for Homebuyers. ٠
- Cited federal register for affordability requirements. ٠
- Added clarification on LMI Homebuver eligibility ٠ requirements.
- Threshold requirements added for applicants 18 or older who . were underage at the time of Hurricane Harvey.
- Cited references for Documentation Tie-back requirements. ٠
- Added language on Record retention and Section 504. ٠
- Updated family definition. .
- Strengthen language indicating that LMI applicants must . have a demonstrated and verifiable connection to Hurricane Harvey.
- Added eligibility requirements for homeowners at the time of the disaster but no longer own the home.
