## Public Notice

The 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan (Con Plan) includes the 2025 Annual Action Plan and constitutes the grant application submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the HOME Investment Partnerships Grant (HOME), the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Grant (HOPWA), and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). The Con Plan is a five-year strategic plan that measures the City's Housing and Community Development Department's (HCDD) efforts to: expand and preserve affordable housing; assist those with special needs; revitalize communities; and provide public improvements to low-and moderate-income neighborhoods.

Throughout the Con Plan development process, HCDD collaborates with stakeholders, residents, neighborhood-based organizations, local housing advocates and non- and for-profit agencies to determine which improvement strategies benefit low- and moderate-income Houstonians. Information about the planning process is made available at the open houses. The Fall 2024 in person Community meeting was held on November 13, 2024, at the Kashmere Multi-Service Center and the Fall 2024 Virtual Community meeting was held on November 17, 2024.

The 2025 Annual Action Plan outlines priorities and describes how the \$49,840,591.00 in federal funds and \$185,646.08 in program income will be used to benefit income-eligible residents during the 2025 Program Year (July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026).
