

Public Notice

On Monday, June 30, 2025, The City of Houston's (City) Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) issued a public notice proposing to allocate Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), and HOME Investment Partnerships Program – American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) funds to participating agencies in its Public Services Program.

The City is issuing a correction increasing the budget allocation to Allies in Hope from \$2,405,000.00 to \$3,135,000.00 HOPWA funds. The revised total maximum budget for the HOPWA allocation to the City's Public Services Program is \$13,145,000.00.
