

## Public Notice

On Friday, May 15, 2026, the City of Houston's (City) Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) issued a public notice proposing an Ordinance to authorize an Eighth Amendment to the Amended and Restated Homebuyer Assistance Program (HAP) Guidelines.

The City is now issuing a correction to the original public notice to state that the household income threshold for households receiving assistance through TIRZ funding may qualify with incomes up to 120% of the Area Median Income (AMI).
