Subdivision. The property includes a historic 1,223 square foot, one-story wood single-family residence and detached garage situated on a 6,600

square foot (50' x 132') interior lot.

Significance: Contributing Bungalow Craftsman Stucco style residence, constructed

circa 1915, located in the Houston Heights East Historic District.

Proposal: Alteration: 2-Story Rear Addition; Windows, Front Door, Stucco Replacement on Original Structure

Original Structure:

- Remove original stucco in order to determine water damage to structural framing and replace with new stucco
- Decrease existing single window opening towards rear of NE elevation
- Remove non-original awning on front porch
- Remove non-original front door and replace with a "stain grade oak" front door

Rear Addition:

- 2-story rear addition totaling 1,639 sq. ft.
 - First floor 593 sq. ft.
 - Second floor 1046 sq. ft.
- Max ridge height at 30' with a roof pitch of 5:12 and composition shingles
- Mix of fixed, single pane and double-hung, 1-over-1, inset & recessed, wood windows
- Stucco cladding to match new stucco on original structure

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





Rear Setbacks (Addition and New Construction)

The City of Houston requires a minimum setback of three feet from the rear property line for all properties, except under the following circumstances:

- A front-facing garage which is located with its rear wall at the alley may have a zero-foot setback.
- An alley-loading garage generally must be located to establish a minimum of 20 feet of
 clearance from an opposing alley-loading garage door, the rear wall of a front-facing garage, or
 a fence; a 24-foot clearance is preferred.






Harris County Building Land Assessment Survey - Dec. 6, 1967






Proposed Site Plan




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
Existing & Proposed First Floor Plan




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Existing Right (South) Elevation




