DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Director's Report was given by Deputy Director, Margaret Wallace Brown. She reported that the Historic planning staff received 22 total Historic applications last month; 10 were administratively reviewed, and 12 are on today's Agenda. The 2017 numbers are as follows: 379 total applications, 157 administratively reviewed, and 222 heard by this Commission.
