B-2. 609 Colquitt Street - Alteration - Addition/Windows/Siding - First Montrose Commons

Motion was made by Commissioner McNeil, seconded by Commissioner Wiedower Jackson, to deny the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-2. Motion carried unanimously. Motion was made by Commissioner McNeil, seconded by Commissioner Aranda, that a Certificate of Remediation be issued for (1) rebuild the front porch to a similar to the original portico removed, with staff's approval of final design (2) replace interior shiplap and provide a written statement from a structural engineer licensed by the State of Texas that the proposed repair or reconstruction can be accomplished without harm to the exterior features of the building or structure visible from the right-of-way. Motion carried unanimously.

B-4. 3806 Garrott Street - Alteration - Roof - First Montrose Commons

Motion was made by Commissioner Bucek, seconded by Commissioner Cosgrove, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-4. Motion carried unanimously.

B-5. 1629 Oxford Street - Alteration – Addition - Houston Heights East – Denial Motion was made by Commissioner McNeil, seconded by Commissioner Srinivasan, to deny the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-5. Motion carried unanimously.

B-6. 735 Columbia Street - New Construction – Residence/Garage - Houston Heights South

Motion was made by Commissioner Wiedower Jackson, seconded by Commissioner Jones, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-6, with the condition that the ridge height not exceed 30', subject to staff approval of revisions. Motion carried with Commissioner McNeil opposing.

Motion was made by Commissioner Koush, seconded by Commissioner Srinivasan, to deny the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-7. Motion carried unanimously. Motion was made by Commissioner Srinivasan, seconded by Commissioner Bucek, to issue a Certificate of remediation with the conditions that the applicant put back and reconstruct porch and exterior siding, interior shiplap to be replaced and reestablish balloon framing, and obtain a certified letter regarding structural integrity from a structural engineer that is familiar with shiplap structures. Motion carried unanimously.

B-12. 1301 Tulane Street - Alteration - Porch/Windows - Houston Heights West

Motion was made by Commissioner Koush, seconded by Commissioner Cosgrove, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-12, with the condition that the windows be painted to match the existing windows on the home and the windows be recessed and inset with a traditional profile. Motion carried unanimously.

B-13. 1416 Rutland Street - Alteration - Addition/Porch/Roof - Houston Heights West Administrative Approval

B-14. 1343 Allston Street - Alteration - Addition - Houston Heights West

Motion was made by Commissioner Koush, seconded by Commissioner Wiedower Jackson, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-14, with the condition that (1) new covered side porch (south side) needs to conform to the 5' side setback as required by the Heights Design Guidelines (2) removal of original siding from the original historic house and replaced in kind, for siding beyond repair, will require site inspection by Staff. Motion carried unanimously.

B-15. 3247 Inwood Drive - Demolition - Residence - LM - Lucien Carroll House

Motion was made by Commissioner Bucek, seconded by Commissioner Cosgrove, to deny the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-15, with the amendment that Commissioner Jones draft a letter for the Chair to send on behalf of the Commission to the owner, expressing the Commission's concerns of the demolition of a landmark. Motion carried unanimously.

B-18. 1012 Algregg Street - Alteration – Addition – Norhill

Motion was made by Commissioner McNeil, seconded by Commissioner Aranda, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-18. Motion carried unanimously.

B-21. 4202 Watson Street - Alteration - Siding/Trim - Norhill

Motion was made by Commissioner Koush, seconded by Commissioner Cosgrove, to deny the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-21. Motion carried unanimously.

B-22, 1135 W Gardner Street - Alteration - Porch - Norhill

Motion was made by Commissioner Bucek, seconded by Commissioner Cosgrove, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-22 with the condition that lattice be installed between piers, leaving the face of piers exposed and no water table. Motion carried unanimously.

B-23. 449 W 19th Street - Alteration - Windows - PLM - Heights Water Works

Motion was made by Commissioner Cosgrove, seconded by Commissioner Jones, to deny the certificate of Appropriateness for removal of the original historic windows and replacement with manufactured vinyl windows. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Commissioner Cosgrove, seconded by Commissioner McNeil to issue a Certificate of Remediation, to replace the vinyl windows with option 3 (custom Steel) proposed by the

applicant. Motion carried unanimously. Motion was made by Commissioner McNeil, seconded by Commissioner Aranda, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness to swap the two existing original steel doors on the south (side) and east (front) elevations with the condition that if the doors are not the same size or inoperable when flipped, the doors should remain where they are. The applicant may have to change the glass on one of the doors to meet egress and code. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Commissioner Koush, seconded by Commissioner McNiel, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-27, with conditions (a) roof of new addition to be hipped with a pitch of no more than 5:12 (b) new addition 2nd floor ceiling height to be no more than 10' (to curb overall height of the new addition (c) new addition fenestration size to match the rough opening of windows of the original historic house (d) new addition fenestration (facing street) pattern to be of 1/1 and accept the revised drawings submitted by the applicant. Motion carried unanimously.

B-28. 3016 Morrison Street - Alteration - Addition - Woodland Heights

Motion was made by Commissioner Bucek, seconded by Commissioner Cosgrove, to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness for item B-28, with the conditions (a) roof pitch of the new addition either match or be lower than original structure (b) existing diamond-shaped ornamentation of front porch to remain. Motion carried unanimously.
